Bow Inspection	Judge will inspect archers' equipment from 10:00hrs.												
Practice	Archers will have six sighters. Sighters will be at 11:00hrs.												
Event Format	<p>Targets: The Clout target will be circular, 15m in diameter and divided into five concentric scoring zones arranged from the centre outwards and each measuring 1.5m in width.</p> <p>The Clout target scoring lines will be determined by a non-stretch cord marked off at the dividing lines. The centre of the Clout target shall be marked by a brightly coloured distinctive flag: the Clout. This flag is affixed to a pole, firmly fixed vertically in the ground.</p> <p>Shooting: Shooting will be in one direction only. 36 arrows for a single Clout round, 72 arrows for a double Clout round. Six sighter arrows shall be shot preceding the commencement of shooting.</p> <p>Scoring: The values of each scoring zone of the Clout target from the centre outwards, are: 5 – 4 – 3 – 2 – 1.</p> <p>Arrows sticking in the Clout, or in the pole, shall score 5.</p> <p>An arrow lying loose on the ground shall be scored in accordance with the position of its point.</p>

Entry Information	<p>Entries MUST be submitted by completing the on-line Entry Form (click link): Entry Form</p> <p>Disabled archers who are unable to get to the target, please try and arrange your own assistant to aid in scoring and arrow collection. If this is not possible, please ensure you have ticked the appropriate box on the entry form and the Tournament Organiser will arrange assistance.</p> <p>In accordance with Archery GB Rule 700(e) all archers must have received instruction in Clout shooting prior to this competition.</p>												
Closing Date for Entries	<p>25/09/2024</p> <p>Entries after the closing date will not be accepted.</p>												
Refunds and Cancellations	<p>If you wish to cancel your space and get a refund, please contact the Tournament Organiser at: tournaments.croesoswalltarchers@btinternet.com</p> <p>Up to 14 days before the event, an 80% refund will be issued.</p> <p>After the 14-day deadline, no refund will be issued.</p>												

Target List, Scoring & Results	<p>Event notifications will be published at www.croesoswalltarchers.co.uk</p> <p>All scoring will be on paper scoresheets, with scores entered onto the i@nseo software for managing archery tournament results.</p> <p>Target lists and results will be published on www.ianseo.net, www.croesoswalltarchers.co.uk and www.shropshirearcherysociety.co.uk</p>
Awards	<p>Medals will be awarded per gender, division (bow style) and age class for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.</p>
Rules and Dress Code	<p>Archery GB Rules of Shooting will apply.</p> <p>Only clothing in compliance with Rule 307 will be permitted. Blue Denim, Olive Drab and Camouflage are not allowed.</p> <p>Archer's names, manufacturers logos, club logos and sponsors logos are allowed. The only other wording or logos permissible must represent archery organisations.</p> <p>The tournament organisers have the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour. The Judge is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times and the Judge's decision is final and must be obeyed.</p>
Lost Arrows	<p>In accordance with Archery GB rules, searches for lost arrows must not delay shooting. Searches for lost arrows may continue after completion of the tournament when the work party may assist.</p> <p>Lost arrows must be reported to the Judge (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow). It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.</p>
Data Protection	<p>By entering this competition you agree that the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors, and some information may also be published on www.ianseo.net, www.croesoswalltarchers.co.uk and www.shropshirearcherysociety.co.uk in the form of target lists and results: name, gender, bow style, age category, date of birth (if junior), club, round, disabled (Y/N).</p> <p>Other personal information collected, e.g. email and telephone number, will not be shared.</p>
Photography	<p>Unauthorised photography is not permitted.</p> <p>In accordance with the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People policy, any person, whether archers or visitors, intending to take photographs, either still or video, are requested to register their intention with the Tournament Organiser on arrival.</p> <p>Entrants bringing visitors to the tournament are asked to make them aware of this requirement.</p> <p>Photos and video taken at this event by Croesoswallt Archers official photographer may be used by the club on its website and social media platforms to promote the club and sport. If you are concerned about any photography taking place at this event, or do not wish to be photographed, please contact the Tournament Organiser. You can request photos to be taken off Croesoswallt Archers website and social media platforms if you do not wish them to be displayed.</p>
Juniors	<p>All competitors under the age of 18 must be supervised by a parent, guardian or other nominated responsible adult.</p>
Parking	<p>There is plenty of parking near the shooting field. Please follow the steward's instructions.</p>
Line Tents	<p>Line tents are permitted for this event and must be sited in the marked areas. Line tents may be erected from 09:30hrs.</p> <p>Please be aware that no naked flames (e.g. camping stoves) are permitted anywhere on site.</p>
Toilets	<p>Chemical toilets are available on the Croesoswallt Archers Ground.</p>
Smoking and Alcohol	<p>Alcohol and smoking, including e-cigarettes and vaping, is NOT permitted anywhere on the Croesoswallt Archers Ground. The smoking area is on the access road to the Croesoswallt Archers Ground.</p> <p>Please ensure that you take your rubbish home with you.</p>
Refreshments	<p>Tea, coffee and squash will be available.</p>
Safeguarding	<p>The Welfare Officer's information will be added to the relevant competition page on www.ianseo.net.</p> <p>The British Ironworks Centre is not open to the public on the day of the competition.</p> <p>Any concerns of suspicious activity should be raised with the Welfare Officer on the day.</p> <p>All children must be supervised by their parent, guardian or other nominated responsible adult.</p>

<p>Pets</p>	<p>Assistance dogs are permitted on the Croesoswallt Archers Ground.</p> <p>Dogs which are not considered to be assistance dogs are only permitted with the prior agreement of the Tournament Organiser.</p> <p>Dog owners should be aware that not all people are comfortable being around dogs and therefore it is the obligation of the dog owner to always maintain the dog on a short (non-extendable) lead, keep the dog behind the Tent Line and clear up their own dog's mess.</p> <p>The presence of a dog should not have any impact on others and their shooting ability, nor the overall safety or enjoyment of the event.</p> <p>If any dog causes issues, displays inappropriate or disruptive behaviour then the Tournament Organiser or Judge are within their capacity to ask the owner to remove the dog from the Croesoswallt Archers Ground.</p>
